
Innovating Regions in Europe: objectives

Rationale & objectives

- A platform for European regions to **exchange experience** and **access good practice** in **regional innovation policies and strategies**
- Set up in mid 90's by the **European Commission**
- **Open** to any European region that is committed to the development of its innovation capacity
- **Key role of local/regional authorities** to promote innovation

Innovating Regions in Europe: achievements

Achievements of regional innovation strategies

- Move towards **strategic thinking**
- Creation of a **regional dialogue**
- Introduction of a broader concept of **innovation**
- Rationalisation of the **innovation support infrastructure**

Innovating Regions in Europe: achievements

Regional innovation strategy projects generated actions in several fields, e.g.

- Strengthening **sectoral business networks** and **clusters**
- Establishment of **interfaces** between businesses and the knowledge base
- Co-ordination of **RTD** and **innovation** services
- Development of **financial instruments** to finance innovation
- Improvement of **market intelligence** services
- Promotion of **innovation projects** in firms
- Facilitation of university/large firms **spin-offs** and **NTBFs**

The IRE Secretariat - role

IRE Secretariat mandate

- **Animate** the IRE network
- Provide **technical support** to IRE member regions
- Facilitate **exchange** of experiences, transfer of **good practice** and inter-regional **learning**
- Offer **meeting** opportunities
- Raise **awareness** of the importance and benefits of innovation for regional development

IRE Secretariat services – examples (1)

1. Help desk

2. Info Point

Tailor-made information on activities and good practices from IRE member regions upon request

Examples of requests:

- Foresight activities
- Innovation culture
- Clusters / networks
- Sectors (agriculture, biotech, aerospace, medical, etc)
- Technology transfer schemes
- Business incubators

IRE Secretariat services – examples (2)

3. Partner search

Innovation-related projects from different EU programmes

4. IRE Study visits

Support to individual IRE members wishing to visit another IRE region on site

Technical support with:

- Identification of the host region
- Preparation of agenda and content
- Organisation of logistics
- Secretariat attendance

5. IRE events

Good practice workshops (e.g.):

- Innovation financing
- Regional foresight
- RIS/RITTS projects implementation

IRE Plenary Conference

- Bi-annual meeting for all IRE members

Thematic events for groups of regions

- Subgroups of regions (academic-industry links; clusters; mutual learning platform)
- Industrial Regions group


