

The company hat a rudimental innovation strategy 41 %











Impact on SMEs: Creation of new collaborations














Impact on SMEs: new jobs












Impact: Vocational prospects of Innovation Assistants











Lessons Learnt from ERIK ACTION

- "Simplicity" and documented results attracted the majority of the ERIK ACTION partners to import (parts of) the NÖ Innovation Assistant
- Experiences of exporting the NÖ Innovation Assistant have underlined the strength of the innovation support system in NÖ
 - No problems with ERDF / ESF responsibilities
 Innovation policy co financed by ERDF
 - Innovation Assistant integrated in holistic regional innovation system: lack of preparation support in other regions require a prestage to define concrete innovation projects in firms
- Improvement of the Innovation Assistant Programme in Lower Austria:
 - Open also for large companies
 - more experienced graduates also accepted,
 if they have been employed at a R&D institution
