Step 1: Build on Previous Projects

- ERIK / ERIK+ Network (*European Regions Knowledge* Based Innovation Network):
- Network involving 50 regions
- Database with 60 GPs

Selection Criteria:

- Availability of results
- Transferability
- Level of Innovation / Risk
- Potential impact on innovation policies / economy / relations / services
- Sustainability







Step 2: Widening the Horizon

 New experiences identified through previous contact (conferences, other projects...)

 Knowledge of experience and needs of new partners Partners discuss their own good practices at regional level with MA / stakeholders to:

- confirm interest in export
- identify other good practices

Draft list of good practices available for transfer







Step 3: Interregional Selection

- Circulation of good practices among all partner / potential partners
- Meeting in Brussels with partners / potential partners (importance of face to face contact)
- Good practice selected according to level of interest / coherence with ERIK ACTION objectives

Final list of good practices available for transfer

Ready for Project application







What makes Good Practices Interesting for a Managing Authority?

- **Simple** must be user-friendly, easy to understand, potential to implement without large scale changes;
- **General** theme wide enough that different realities can find aspects of interest; not linked to one specific sector or easily adaptable.







Lessons Learned: Weaknesses and Strengths

Weaknesses:

- Good practices proposed for political reasons
- Transfer seen as opportunity for publicity
- Needs further cross analysis with regional realities

Strengths:

- Preparing in good time
- Peer Evaluation
- Building on previous knowledge and experience
- Keep on learning
- Consensus
