
- * **Chalmers Innovation Business Incubator in Göteborg (private foundation) 1999. Two incubators**

Finance

- * **Grants to develop business ideas from students and researchers (2´ - 10´). Funding from the Technology Bridge Foundation in the region.**
- * **Seed Finance with grants (up to 15´) and loans with terms (up to 70´) to young technology based and knowledge based companies with possibilities on "global" market. Funding from the Region**
- * **Connect West (private - public partnership).
Links entrepreneurs and young companies to financial resources (and also links to private business resources)**
- * **Early- stage VC-capital for academic start-ups in Göteborg (a public and a private-public company)**
