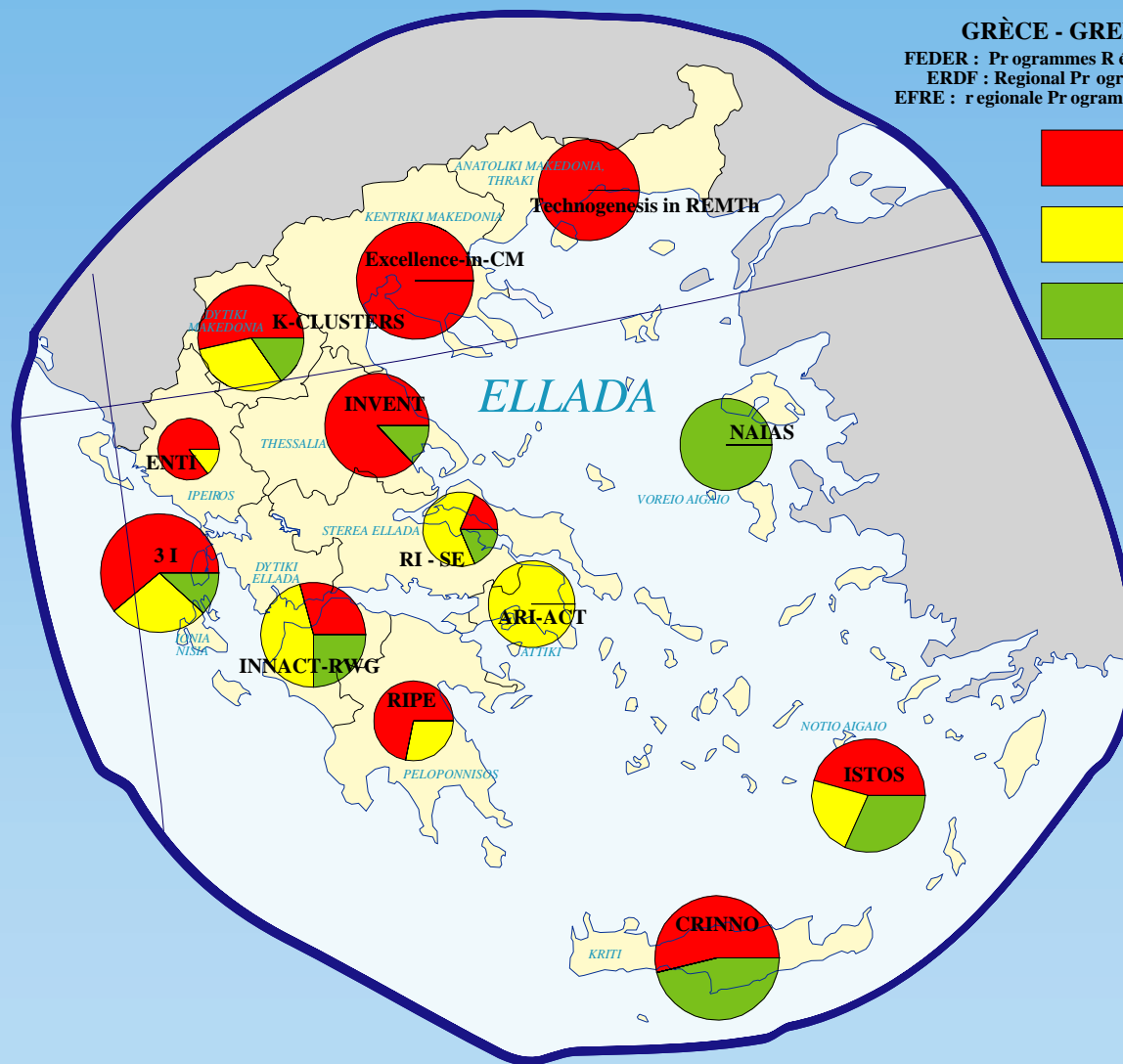

- Public-Private Partnerships

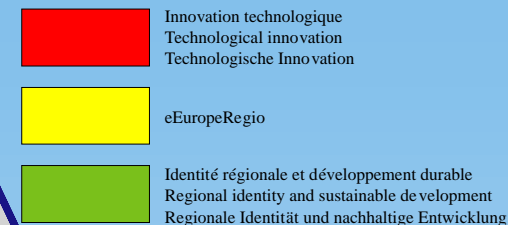

ERDF : Regional Pr ogrammes of Inno vative Actions 2001-2006

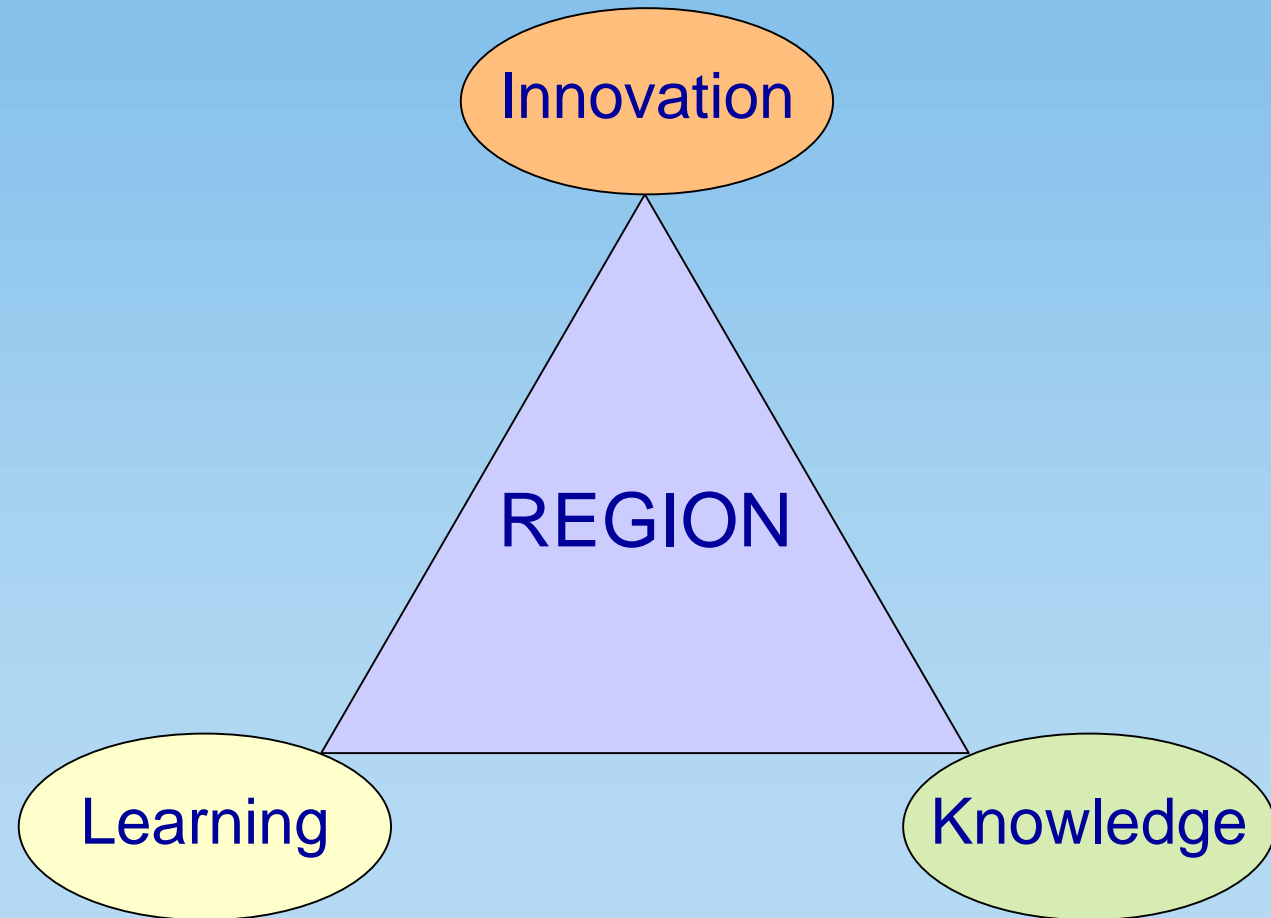
